



KINGS HEATH SQUASH CLUB – MEMBERS’ CODE OF CONDUCT

Kings Heath Squash Club exists in order for it’s members to enjoy themselves, to maintain and improve their physical fitness by playing squash and to build friendships with fellow members as well as those from other clubs.

We are dedicated to providing members with an environment in which everyone will be treated civilly, fairly and with respect.

We believe that squash is a sport for all, that anyone can enjoy however they choose to participate – as a player, coach, official, volunteer, parent or spectator.

This Code of Conduct provides guidelines for the expected behaviours, at all times, of all members, guests and visitors at Kings Heath Squash Club.

If you participate or are otherwise involved in any way in the game at Kings Heath, then this Code applies to you.

Expected Behaviours

The expected behaviours of all members of KH Squash Club include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Conduct yourself with integrity – be modest in victory and gracious in defeat.
- Treat all others equally, with courtesy and respect
- Take all reasonable measures to protect your own safety and the safety of others on and around the courts. This includes a recommendation for adults to wear suitable eye protection and a requirement for juniors (U19).
- Exhibit a spirit of good sportsmanship and fairness both on and off the court.
- Understand and play by the rules – play hard, but play fair.
- Be honest, consistent, objective and courteous when applying the rules of the game
- Set a positive example for others, particularly children, spectators and visitors
- Use the club’s facilities and equipment responsibly. If things are broken, let us know !
- Be familiar with all other applicable Club policies and procedures available via the Club website (www.kingsheathsquashclub.co.uk>fees>ClubRules&ByeLaws)

Members should report any alleged incidents of unacceptable behaviour, whether directed towards themselves or others, to a member of the squash club committee. The committee will investigate and deal with all concerns, complaints or incidents in a fair and timely manner while, as far as is possible, respecting the complainant’s privacy.

Members who are deemed to have violated this Code may face disciplinary action up to and including suspension or revocation of their membership.
